The True Grower™ will be responsible for all aspects of cannabis cultivation, including:

- Production scheduling
- Genetics selection
- Managing all phases of plant growth
- Calculating, mixing, and applying appropriate plant nutrients
- Troubleshooting and correcting nutrient deficiencies or toxicities in plants
- Monitoring water quality and nutrient levels for all irrigation
- Designing and implementing an Integrated Pest Management program
- Managing environmental growing conditions
- Training and scheduling work for the cultivation team
- Coordinating harvests with the post-harvest manager
- Scheduling maintenance and timely repair of growing equipment
- Establishing a calibration schedule for all nutrient testing instruments
- Ensuring cleanliness of cultivation facility at all times
- Guaranteeing daily record keeping for production accuracy and regulatory compliance
- Enforcing staff compliance with the inventory tracking system
- Organizing R&D activities to test new equipment, varieties, and growing techniques
- Complying with all regulations, audits, and inspections of the grow facility
- Collaborating with consultants
